Quick User's Guide

Issuing Reports

- To open the data to be analyzed: first select the type of database from the Open Data of Type drop down menu then click the Open Data of Type button. Select the data source from the Open window.
- In the Basic Data tab the directory and name of the table that you selected is displayed in the Data Source text box. In the Field Grid the names of all the fields and the analysis parameters to be determined are displayed.
- The Second Data tab should be filled in only when you wish to compare two data sets; the first dataset is opened in the basic data tab and the second dataset in the second data tab. In the field grid of second data tab match the related fields from the two datasets.
- Click the **Issue Reports** button and *WizSame* will analyze the data to find the similar records.

Viewing The Reports

- Once *WizSame* is finished analyzing the data and finds similar and/or duplicate records the report can be reviewed in the WizSame Matching Set window.
- The report lists the content of the matching records.
 - A green checkmark ✓ designates identical values.
 - A yellow checkmark \checkmark with a red X designates similar values.
 - No mark is displayed when the field is ignored.
- In the lower middle pane, the number of the matching sets is displayed as well as arrows used for navigating through all of the matching records.
